Since 2008, **Super Saturday!** has grown from a school cafeteria to the historic 50,000 square foot Harlem Armory.

Participation increased from 200 to 1,500 children and parents.

Over 45 NYC organizations and major institutions have partnered.

In 2011, 26 District 5 schools displayed student-based exhibits.


